



# WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

## SOUTHAMPTON EXPLORER

Campers will be outdoors in wet and sunny conditions. Below is a list of recommended items to make your camper's experience safe and more pleasurable.

- Swimwear you will be comfortable in while exploring the marsh, kayaking and paddle boarding
- Rash-guard, and/or quick-dry clothing.
- Water resistant sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Hat
- Polarized Sunglasses with straps
- Quick dry towel (microfiber) medium to large
- Water shoes (optional)-the shores can be rocky
- Reusable water bottle
- A change of dry clothing for off-water activities
- Athletic shoes/socks for off-water activities
- Light rain jacket on rainy days
- Life jacket- you may bring your own, purchase an Explorer Camp PFD or use one from our rental line. (Must be a class 3 PFD)
